

Commack South Girls Softball Rules Minors & Majors

- * Max game time is 2 hours and 15 minutes from the scheduled start time.
- * No new inning may begin 2 hours after the scheduled start time.
- * A team will be deemed to have won if they lead by 20 or more runs and each team has had equal at bats and it is after the 4th inning. Home team need not bat in bottom 4th if leading.
- * A pitcher once removed by choice, who remains in the game at another defensive position, may return to pitch again in the same game, provided she still has innings available.
- * Upon the 3rd mound conference in an inning, or the 4th in a game with the same pitcher, that pitcher must be removed.

Specific Rules for Girls Minors 9-10

- * In the Girls Minors Division a max of 5 Runs per inning may be scored. After the 5th run scores, the inning is over and the teams switch sides. The only exception is the final inning where there is no limit. Both coaches should get together with the umpire to agree which inning will be the final one based on the time remaining in the game.
- * Teams are allowed 3 steals per inning, and are not allowed to steal home.
- * A pitcher in the Minors Division can walk a maximum of 4 batters per inning. After the 4th walk, if she gets to 3 balls on another batter, the offensive coach comes in and pitches a maximum of 5 pitches to the batter until either the batter puts the ball in play or strikes out swinging. Whatever strikes the batter had from the pitcher would still be in effect when the coach begins pitching to the batter. After 5 pitches from the coach, the batter would be called out for not swinging. The pitcher then returns and pitches to the next batter.
- * For the purposes of the above rule, a HBP will be treated as a walk.
- * A pitcher must be removed from the game if she hits 3 batters in any inning, or upon the 4th hit batter in a game.

Specific Rules for Girls Majors 11-12

- * In the Girls Majors there are no limits on runs, steals, or walks per inning.
- * Players may steal home.
- * A pitcher must be removed from the game if she hits 3 batters in any inning, or upon the 4th hit batter in a game.

Pitching Limitations

- * The calendar week is Sunday thru Saturday.
- * The delivery of a single pitch in an inning, constitutes having pitched a full inning.
- * A pitcher remaining in the game, but moving to a different position, can return as a pitcher anytime in the remainder of the game, but only once in the same inning as she was removed.
- * 1 day of rest means a full calendar day that no pitch is thrown.

Weekly Pitching Charts must be maintained by the Managers and produced upon request at any game were there could be an impact.

All entries must be countersigned by the opposing manager.

Failure to maintain a Pitching Charts in accordance with League

Rules may result in forfeiture of games played, and necessitate action by the Board.

At the conclusion of every game both Managers should e-mail your division director the score of the game and who pitched for both teams with the number of innings pitched
