

Commack South Little League Non – Competitive Division's

T-Ball, Map, Minors & Farms

Specific Game Rules All Non-Competitive Divisions:

- There is No leading, No stealing bases, No triples or Homeruns (unless over the fence). If it is a good hit send them to second base, but don't send them on errors or overthrows.
- Every player is in the line-up. No player should be sitting at these levels. Put a normal infield on the field and put everyone else in the outfield.
- Do not allow a player to play on 2nd base.
- The manager or coach pitches to their own team.
- No Bunting

NEW RULE FOR 2010: Each team will bat the same number of batters.

Ex. If team **A** shows up with 11 boys and team **B** has 7 boys then team **B** will Bat 11 boys. If your team is short you must keep track of your batting order so the same kids aren't always batting twice.

T-Ball Specific *Safety Ball Used*

- Every kid gets a hit, every at bat. They run 1 base at a time except for the last batter of each inning she gets a homerun to clear the bases. Everyone will want to hit a homerun so rotate the batting order. The team in the field should remain on the field until the batter touch's home plate.

Map Specific: * Safety Ball Used*

- Managers/Coaches pitch the entire game to their team. There are no walks or strikeouts. It is easiest to pitch from one knee, throw overhand.
- Runners advance 1 base at a time. Last batter clears the bases.
- Team fielding the ball should throw to first base even when batter is safe just to get used to it. If batter is thrown out she still stays on the base.

Minors Specific:

- The first 3 innings the kids will pitch. The remaining innings will be Coach pitched.
- Max is 1 inning per pitcher per game.
- After the 4th walk of an inning the Coach of the team at bat pitches the remainder of the inning. (A HBP is considered a walk). The pitcher must be removed upon hitting 3 batters.
- The inning ends when every kid has batted. **See new rule above

Farms Specific:

- The kids will pitch the entire game. Upon the pitcher giving up 4 walks, a HBP will be considered a walk. He must be replaced by the Manager/Coach who will then complete the inning. The same pitcher can return the next inning.
- There is a 2 inning max per pitcher per game.
- A pitcher is done for the day after his 3rd hit batter of game.
- The team batting will bat until everyone has batted. * See rule above or the defense records 3 outs.
